


Isaac Watts, 1709 Transcribed from Kentucky Harmony, 1817. (Hymn 30, Book 2) 66. 86. (S. M.)

This tune was first published in Kentucky Harmony in 1816. It was reprinted (sometimes slightly revised) in many music books following that, including a three-part version in Southern Harmony (1835), p. 23. It appeared in The Sacred Harp, p. 52 from 1844 to the present, in a four-part version.

The words to the first stanza have been modified; the original reads "Come, we that love the Lord, and let our joys be known,..."
