These chants have been transcribed from the manuscript Oxford, Christ Church, Mus. 49. They are in Turner's own hand and were copied in the late seventeenth century. The originals are in open score with the treble, alto, tenor and bass voices each in their eponymous clefs. This transcription compresses the chants into closed score, but Turner's key signatures, note values, rhythms, barring, figured bass numbers, slurs and underlay (such as it is) have been retained.
